- Report compares various definitions of PHS; relies on the EU working definition of PHS



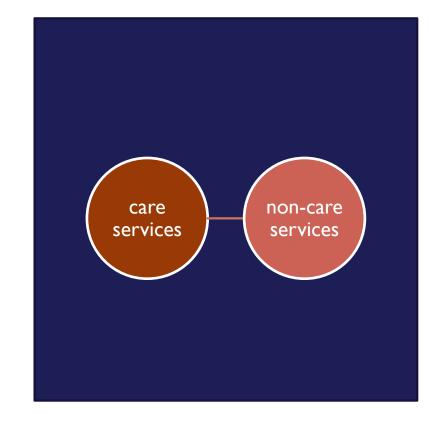

 Challenge: Collecting comprehensive information across all countries

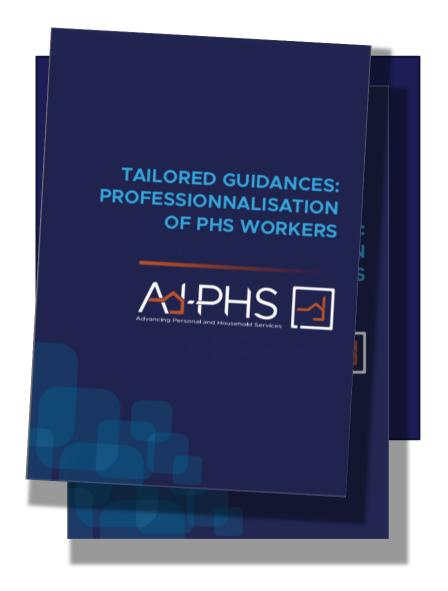
- PHS still insufficiently recognized and supported by European institutions and national public authorities

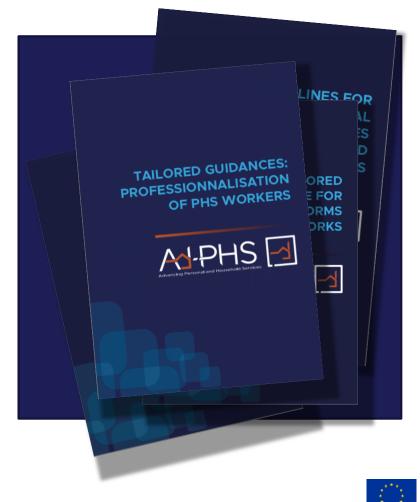

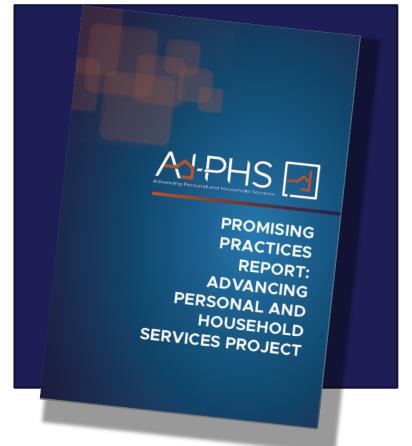
